

Netanyahu Addresses Everything

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Something unusual happened this week. For the first time since October 7, 2023, Prime Minister Netanyahu sat down for an extended, in-depth interview that solicited answers to almost every question, every accusation, that Israelis—and everyone else—have been expressing over the past two and a half years. In 80 minutes on 60 Minutes Overtime, Netanyahu addressed the war with Iran, its nuclear weapons program, and the status of its Islamist regime. He spoke about Hezbollah in Lebanon and Hamas in Gaza. He confronted recent controversies about Christians in Israel head-on. He acknowledged Israel is losing the war on its Eighth Front—the information war. And for the first time, he addressed the question of accountability for October 7th. Is the war with Iran over? No, because of these specific questions. How close is Iran to a nuclear weapon? Iran could have a bomb within a month or two. Is regime change possible? Netanyahu doesn't promise it, but he doesn't dismiss it either. And the accusations of genocide, bot farms, fake addresses, and coordinated foreign operations targeting American opinion? The only weapon against lies is the truth. Just like Daniel prayed and fasted for 21 days over Persia, we too are called to spiritual battle. Armor up.
